**A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE UPDATED SAN MARCELINO LOCAL CLIMATE CHANGE ADAPTATION PLAN (LCCAP) FOR THE PLANNING YEAR 2025-2030 AND ENDORSING IT TO THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN FOR ADOPTION**

**WHEREAS**, Republic Act No. 9729, also known as the "Climate Change Act of 2009," provides the legal basis for local government units (LGUs) to develop and implement Local Climate Change Action Plans (LCCAPs) in response to the growing impact of climate change;

**WHEREAS**, climate change poses significant risks to the Municipality of San Marcelino, including increased frequency and intensity of extreme weather events, rising sea levels, and shifts in climate patterns that may affect agriculture, biodiversity, public health, and local livelihoods;

**WHEREAS**, the Local Climate Change Adaptation Plan (LCCAP) of San Marcelino is a comprehensive document designed to guide the municipality in addressing the challenges posed by climate change, promoting resilience, sustainability, and adaptive capacity across all sectors;

**WHEREAS**, the updated LCCAP for the planning period 2025-2030 integrates the latest scientific data, risk assessments, and feedback from local stakeholders and experts, ensuring that it remains relevant and responsive to the evolving climate risks and opportunities faced by the municipality;

**WHEREAS**, the Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (MDRRMC), in coordination with the Municipal Planning and Development Office (MPDO), has thoroughly reviewed and endorsed the updated LCCAP, which outlines key strategies and interventions to mitigate the effects of climate change and promote sustainable development in San Marcelino;

**WHEREAS**, the approval and subsequent adoption of the updated LCCAP by the Sangguniang Bayan is critical to ensure its formal integration into the municipality's planning processes and the mobilization of resources for its effective implementation;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, on motion of Marvin R. Beltran, duly seconded by Hon. Manuel P. Arquero, Jr., be it:
