A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE AUGMENTATION OF FUNDS FOR CURRENT YEAR (C.Y. 2024) PROJECTS, PROGRAMS, AND ACTIVITIES (PPAs) – DISASTER PREPAREDNESS THEMATIC AREA: CONDUCT OF CAPACITY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMS ON DISASTER PREVENTION AND MITIGATION, DISASTER PREPAREDNESS, DIASTER RESPONSE AND EARLY RECOVERY, AND DISASTER REHABILITATION AND UPDATING OF DRRM-CCA PLANS FROM THE UNEXPENDED BALANCES OF OTHER CURRENT YEAR (C.Y. 2024) 5% MUNICIPAL DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT FUND INVESTMENT PLAN (MDRRFIP) PPAs

WHEREAS, Section 2 of Republic Act No. 10121, also known as the “Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Act of 2010,” mandates strengthening disaster risk reduction and management (DRRM) systems at the local level through comprehensive DRRM plans, programs, and activities;

WHEREAS, Section 21 of R.A. 10121 provides that at least 5% of a local government unit’s estimated revenue shall be allocated to the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund (LDRRMF) to support essential projects and activities aligned with disaster prevention, mitigation, preparedness, response, and rehabilitation;

WHEREAS, in line with DBM-DILG Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2013-1, unexpended LDRRMF balances can be reallocated within the fiscal year, upon approval by the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council, for necessary programs and projects that enhance disaster preparedness and response capabilities;

WHEREAS, the Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (MDRRMC) of San Marcelino recognizes the urgent need to enhance the municipality’s disaster preparedness, response, and resilience by conducting capacity development programs and updating Disaster Risk Reduction and Management – Climate Change Adaptation (DRRM-CCA) plans;

WHEREAS, utilizing the unexpended balances of the C.Y. 2024 5% MDRRM Fund Investment Plan for these capacity-building and plan updating initiatives will ensure that San Marcelino is well-prepared to address, mitigate, and recover from potential disasters, thus reinforcing the safety and security of the community;

WHEREAS, for proper and orderly recording, documentation, and accounting purposes, the Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (MDRRMC) deems it essential to refer to the attached schedule of augmentation for the specified Projects, Programs, and Activities (PPAs) as “Annex A”, thereby ensuring transparency, accuracy, and ease of reference in the utilization of funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Engr. Armida L. Fabelinia, duly seconded by Ms. Sahra V. Soria, it is hereby:


