A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE PROGRAMMING OF THE C.Y. 2024 5% MUNICIPAL DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT FUND INVESTMENT PLAN (MDRRMFIP) DUE TO THE ADDITIONAL INCOME OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF SAN MARCELINO FROM THE SHARE OF THE COLLECTION OF DREDGING OPERATIONS FOR THE MONTHS OF AUGUST AND SEPTEMBER 2024, AND THE COLLECTION OF QUARRY EXTRACTION FOR THE MONTHS OF MAY, JUNE, JULY, AUGUST, AND SEPTEMBER 2024 BY THE PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT OF ZAMBALES FOLLOWING THE REQUIRED ALLOCATION OF 70% MITIGATION FUND AMOUNTING TO Php 252,000.00 AND 30% QUICK RESPONSE FUND (QRF) AMOUNTING TO Php 108,000.00 ONLY

WHEREAS, Section 15 of Republic Act No. 10121, otherwise known as the "Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Act of 2010," mandates the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (LDRRMC) to recommend the approval of the LDRRMF investment plans to ensure the efficient and proper utilization of funds for disaster prevention, mitigation, preparedness, response and early recovery, and rehabilitation;

WHEREAS, the Municipality of San Marcelino recognizes the need to update its C.Y. 2024 5% MDRRMFIP to include the additional income from the dredging operations for the months of August and September 2024, and the quarry extraction collections for the months of May to September 2024;

WHEREAS, the share of the Municipality from these collections, as remitted by the Provincial Government of Zambales reflecting 5% amounts to Php 360,000.00, broken down into a 70% Mitigation Fund of Php 252,000.00 and a 30% Quick Response Fund (QRF) of Php 108,000.00, in accordance with the guidelines on disaster risk reduction and management fund utilization;

WHEREAS, the MDRRMC recognizes the importance of properly programming these additional funds to ensure alignment with the objectives of disaster prevention, mitigation, preparedness, and quick response in the municipality;

WHEREAS, the programming of these additional funds shall strengthen the implementation of appropriate infrastructure projects, capacity-building initiatives, and emergency response activities that enhance disaster resilience in the Municipality of San Marcelino;

WHEREAS, this resolution seeks to promote transparency and accountability in the use of the additional income and ensure that the funds are utilized effectively for the safety and welfare of the community;

1. Procurement of Equipment, PPEs, Flood Mitigation, Slope Protection, Data Base, and Monitoring for Immediate Response, Search and Rescue, Fire Rescue, and EMR services.	Php 119,000.00
2. Provision of Tents and Other Temporary Shelter Facilities	Php 133,000.00
